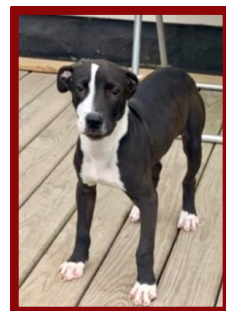


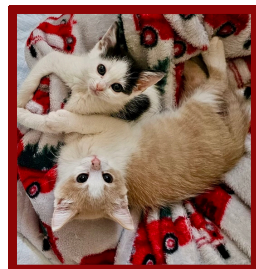
Atticus: A Tale of Compassion and Collaboration

After Atticus improved, FIDO reached out to ARPO for further vet assistance and his neuter, and the FIDO volunteer even became an ARPO foster. Resilience and Recovery: kittens on road to home for the holidays



Dulce, Cowgirl, and Licorice were part of a litter of five kittens found living in unsafe outdoor conditions in Indianapolis. Undernourished and small for their age, they arrived at an ARPO foster home in fragile health. Sadly, one kitten passed away before reaching ARPO, and another, Pumpkin, died the first night in foster care. The surviving three, Dulce, Cowgirl, and Licorice, have required multiple vet visits, with Licorice even spending a night in the hospital. Despite the challenges, they are showing great improvement thanks to dedicated care. Soon, they'll start routine vaccinations and vetting, just in time to find their forever homes for the holidays!

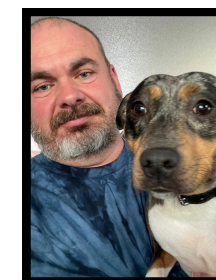
Years of Rescue
